With waterfalls to the northeast of the island, the southwest has deep water close to shore and easy access to the world famous Rainbow Reef - a 20 mile pristine reef system with over 40 dive sites is covered in soft and hard corals giving Taveuni the reputation of being in the heart of the 'Soft Coral Capital of the World'! The Great White Wall is noted as one of the Top 10 Dive Sites in the World and situated on the Rainbow Reef.

Protected from the trade wind by rainforest covered mountains, Paradise enjoys calm, clear waters year round making it the perfect destination for scuba divers, as well as those looking for a tranquil getaway. Paradise Taveuni

How to get to Paradise - International flight to Nadi (pr: nan-dee) followed by domestic flight to Taveuni's Matei Airport 2-4 times daily from Nadi and Suva. Paradise is a scenic 60 minute drive from the airport to the resort and Airport transfers are included in the nightly tariff. You can also arrive via speedboat.
